He explained this with the help of 6 colourful hats -where white hat means facts, red hat means emotions/feelings, yellow hat stands for identifying usefulness of an idea, blue hat means process of thinking needed, black hat means cautions, difficulties, dangers, spotting the risks & weaknesses and green hat means creativity.
