REPORT OF GO GREEN PROGRAM

Vidya Devi Jindal School, Hisar has started the GO GREEN Program with Edible Routs.

Session-1

This was conducted by Ms Tanisha and Ms Divya for the students of classes VII and VIII. Students were divided in two groups i.e. Sarojini and Kasturba House students were in one group and Savitri and Laxmibai house students were in second group. The introductory session was conducted in



LRC, where with the help of PPT they explained the concept and need of organic farming. After this all the students were taken to farming site and they were explained about the ecosystem, soil, bed formation and drip irrigation system. Students enjoyed the activity conducted by them using thread and some paper slips showing different parts of ecosystem. Both of them have discussed about the possibilities of compost formation with mess manager and Estate Officer and also visited the School's Farm House to check the possibility of utilizing that land part also but water scarcity in that area is a big challenge.

SESSION –II(SEPTEMBER-5)

The session began in the Learning Resource Centre with the resource person Ma'am Divya explaining the participants about the types of seeds and the methods to grow seeds. It was followed by a practical session in the school farming area, where students were trained how to plant seeds in an organic way. The session created awareness among learners about methods and techniques to practice organic farming. They also learnt about the drip irrigation. The session was conducted House wise for the students of class VII & VIII.

SESSION-III (SEPTEMBER 23-24)

The session began in the Residence one with the resource person Ma'am Divya & Ma'am Tanisha. The recourse person explained about the types of seeds and the methods to grow seeds. They were taught to design their own beds using graph sheets with the concept of companion plants. All the groups were very enthusiastic about the activity and they came up with good plans.

SESSION IV (NOVEMBER6)

In the 4th session students worked in the farming site and have done the activities to find the percolation rate of different soil and binding nature of different soil and they performed and activity to understand the soil profile.

Along with the routine sessions conducted by GO GREEN the students visit the farming site on regular basis and see the growth of their plants and they talk to gardener working there and sometimes help in removing the weeds. Students of KASTURBA House also have reaped some RADISH, ROCKET- PALAK and CORIANDER. Students were very happy to see their plants grown and they were very appreciative about the grown plants and were suggesting everyone to have Radish and coriander chutney and they requested their friends not to waste any food.
