REPORT OF GO GREEN WASTE MANAGEMENT SESSION JANUARY 21-23, 2023

Under the Go Green Program of the school awareness sessions on WASTE MANAGEMENT were organized for all the students of classes VII & VIII. Under this project different activities were conducted as follows:

1. On day one i.e. January 21 general discussion regarding the waste management system of the surroundings was conducted in the common room of Kasturba house with the help of AV tools and everyone decided to segregate the DRY and WET waste and proper management of both in a purposeful way.
2. Same day after lunch team of Kasturba house reported near ORGANIC FARMING Site and all the students worked together to create a composting unit. In the evening same activity was conducted by SAR House team as well.



3. On 2nd day the teams of Laxmibai House and Savitri House also conducted the same activity after breakfast in their respective slots.

4. On the same day an awareness session regarding waste segregation and managing plastic waste by creating Eco-bricks using waste bottles and used plastic wrappers was conducted for all the staff members. This session was attended by around 40 staff members and everyone agreed upon on segregating DRY and WET Waste at their places. They also agreed to create Eco-bricks. After that the same session was conducted for Support Staff families also which was attended by 75 members. They have also promised to segregate the DRY and WET Waste.



5. After lunch the team of Kasturba and Sarojini House also learnt how to create Eco-bricks by stuffing the waste empty plastic bottles by used wrappers. Students were very excited and within 45-50 minutes each house has created 5-6 Eco-bricks each. 5-6 Cartoons full of bread wrappers and milk wrappers were stuffed in 5-6 plastic small (500ml) bottles within no time. Next day also same activity was conducted for Laxmibai and Savitri House students. In two days all the students together have made 24 Eco-bricks. They have been asked to create more such bricks by using the wrappers of Sunday Tuck. It was a smart way to deal with the plastic waste and later on these eco-bricks can be used to create beautiful structures in the school. It was an enriching experience for all. GO GREEN team will continue the activity of waste segregation, composting and eco-bricks with the help of entire school community.
