मेरे शहर लखनऊ का इतिहास

लखनऊ प्राचीन कोसल राज्य का हिस्सा था। यह भगवान राम की विरासत थी जिसे उन्होंने अपने भाई लक्ष्मण को समर्पित कर दिया था। अतः इसे लक्ष्मणावती, लक्ष्मणपुर या लखनपुर के नाम से जाना गया, जो बाद में बदल कर लखनऊ हो गया। यहां से अयोध्या भी मात्र 80 मील दूरी पर स्थित है। लखनऊ का नाम कैसे पड़ा इस पर मतभेद है। मुस्लिम इतिहासकारों के मतानुसार बिजनौर के शेख यहां आये और 1526ए डी में बसे और रहने के लिए उस समय के वास्तुविद लखना पासी की देखरेख में एक किला बनवाया जो लखना किला के नाम से जाना गया। समय के साथ धीरे—धीरे लखना किला लखनऊ में परिवर्तित हो गया। प्राचीन हिन्दू साहित्य के अनुसार यहां भगवान राम के सौनेले भाई लक्ष्मण का जन्म हुआ था जो लाखनपुर से बदलते बदलते लखनऊ हो गया जो अधिक सत्य प्रतीत होता है क्यों कि आज तक किसी वास्तुविद के नाम पर किसी नगर का नाम नहीं रखा गया।




