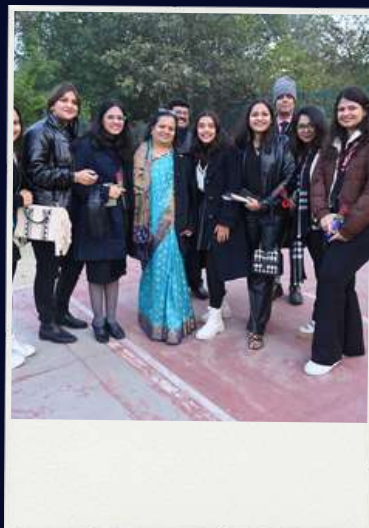

ALUMNAE MEET

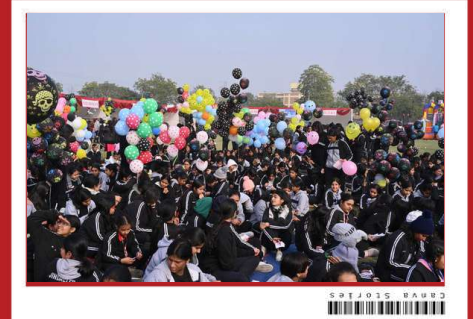

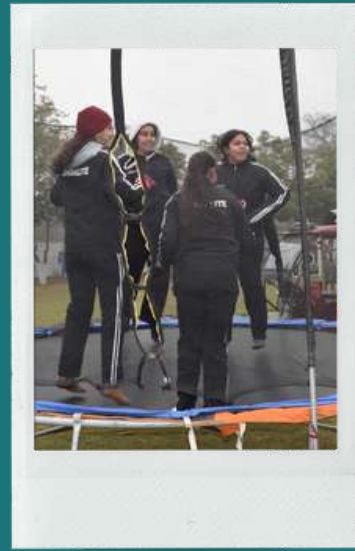
WINTER CARNIVAL

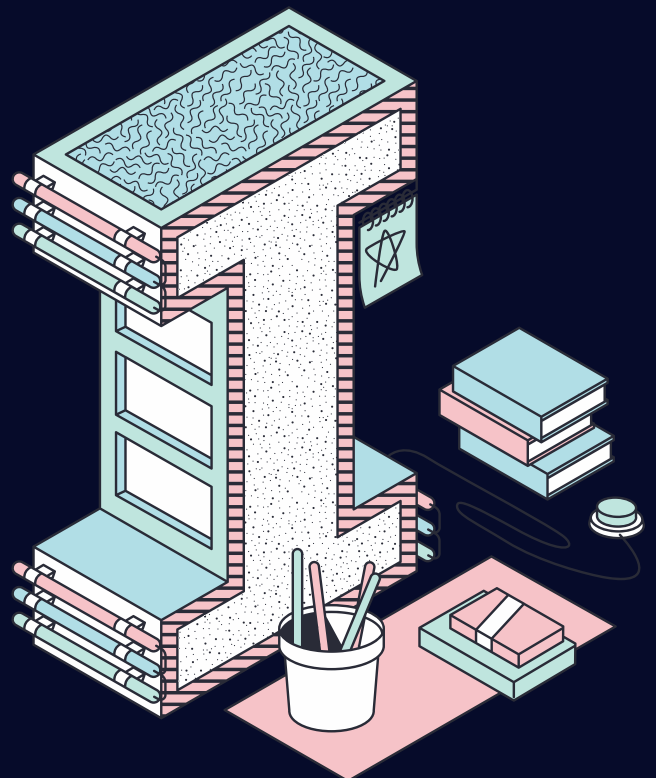
