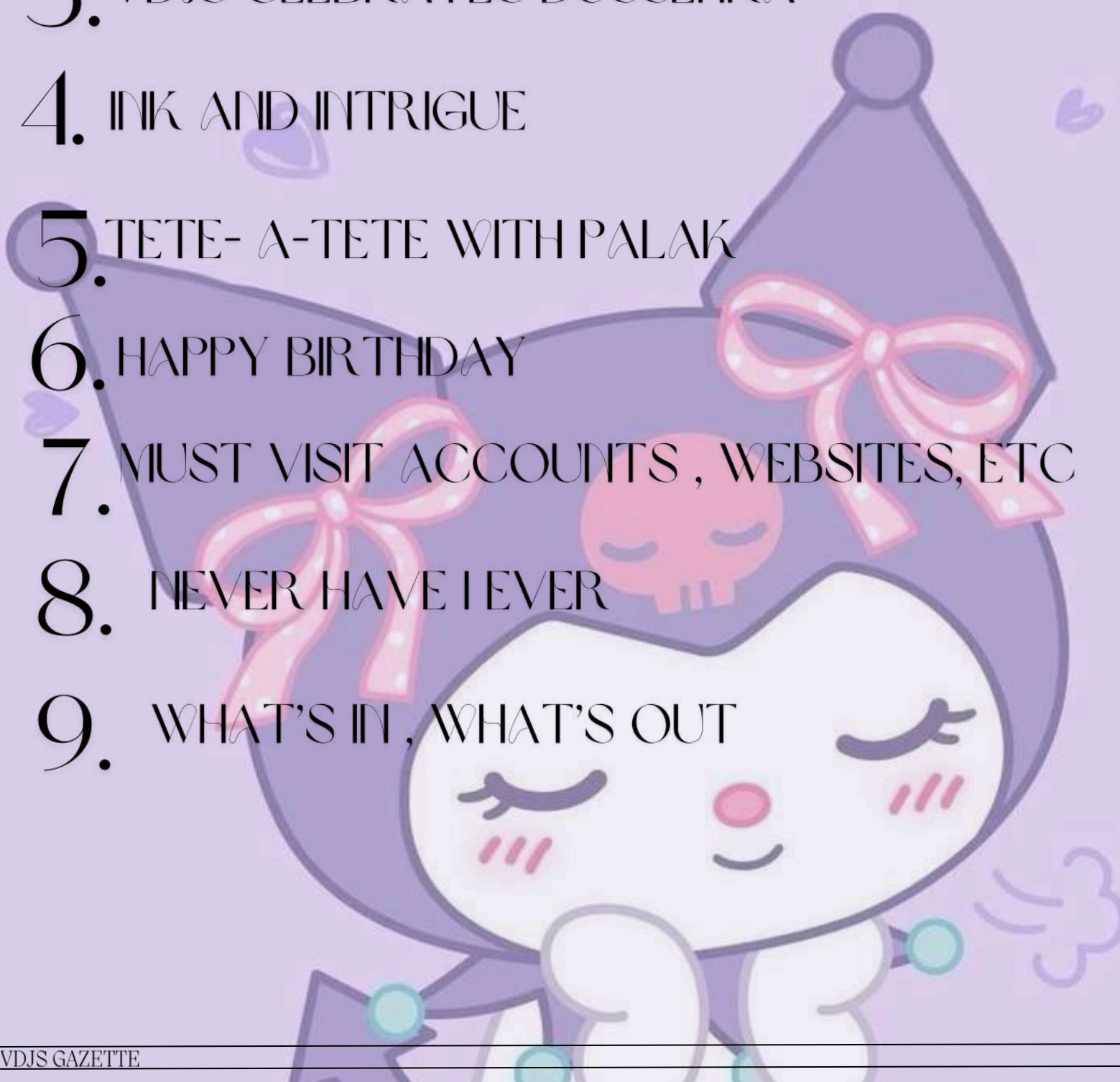

9. If you could live in any fictional world, which one would you choose?

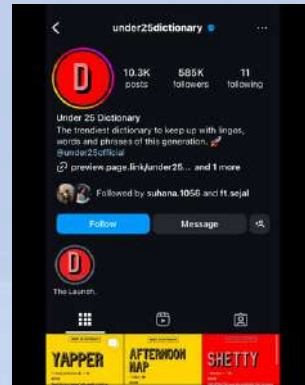
I would go with Harry Potter. The idea of attending Hogwarts gives me Goosebumps.

10. If you could time travel, would you go to the past or the future and why? Definitely, future. I would want to see if humans still exists or AI has taken over.

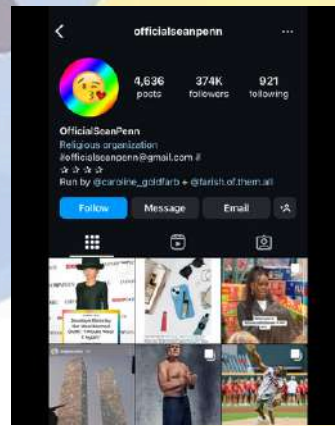
