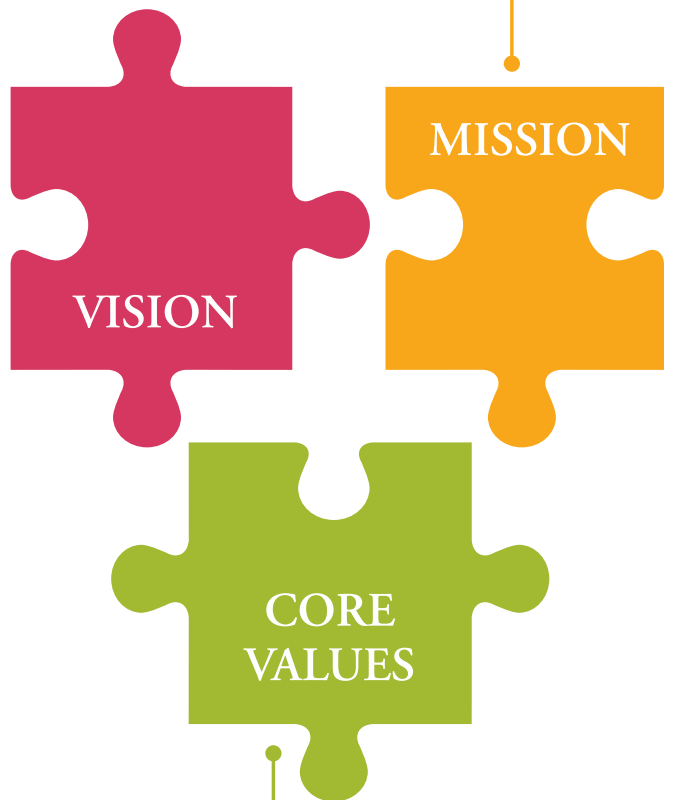

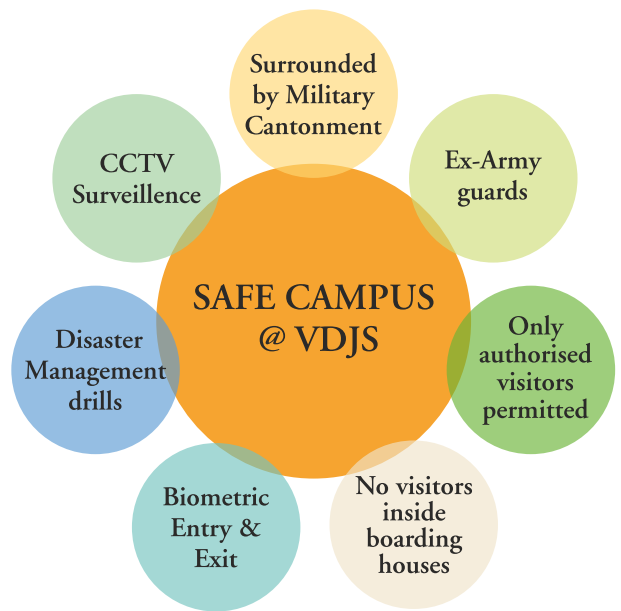

CRADLE OF CARE

There are Four Boarding Houses For classes VI to XII and a Holding House for classes IV & V. The residential staff is in loco parentis for the 650 girls residing in the four Boarding Houses and is supported by a Residential Counsellor to cater to any psychological or emotional needs of the student living away from home. The child is monitored by the pastoral staff and by her teachers to ensure her overall well being. In case of any concerns, individual counselling sessions, group awareness, and psycho education sessions are provided to address the mental, social, and psychological well being with utmost positive and life-oriented approaches.

Each House is equipped with all the basic amenities: including 24x7 power back up and water supply, centralised cooling, solar water heating system, refrigerated drinking water, conducive projection and recreation rooms, mini library, study rooms and Wi-Fi facility.

Weekly phone call facility through cell phones for each child, helps to maintain a healthy connect of the child with her family members. Phone call facility through phone booth for every child helps to communicate with family members.



WELLNESS CENTRE

Medical care is available 24x7 on the campus by a lady Resident Medical Officer who is assisted by trained paramedical staff. The school has a 10 bedded wellness centre comprising one General Ward, an Isolation Ward, a Meditation Room, a Physiotherapy Lab, a Pathological Lab and a Dental Chair with OPD and specialist OPD room. The periodic, Bi-annual medical checkup is done by the school RMO and the Annual checkup is done by the eye, ENT, Dental and Skin visiting medical specialists from Jindal Hospital. In an emergency, a student is referred to the nearby O.P. Jindal Institute of Medical Sciences in Hisar. A medical history of each student is maintained in the Wellness Center for reference. The school is also equipped with an ambulance for conveyance of patients, if required.

SHAPING YOUNG MINDS

VDJS campus is Wi-Fi enabled to promote IT based Teaching / Learning culture. All classrooms are equipped with digital smart boards where learning becomes fun. The students are nurtured in such an environment that they become more receptive and eager to learn. The focus lies on teaching the students through experiential learning. The classroom ambience nourishes and stimulates their imagination for interactive participation.

EMBRACING TECHNOLOGY

The school promotes hands on experience on computers from class IV onwards. Department of Information Technology in VDJS is equipped with two computer labs. One lab equipped with 35 Computers and another N-Computing Lab equipped with 48 consoles. All systems are well connected with internet (Wired and Wi-Fi) with high speed of 24MBPS and local network. All departments and classrooms are equipped with projector and interactive boards with Wi-Fi connectivity to deliver lectures through multimedia. The school has its well defined IT policy which covers all the students and staff. By signing the policy, the students of classes IX-XII are allowed to keep their personal laptops.

The Department organises various Inter-House competitions like 3-D Modelling, Brochure Designing, Ad making, Movie making, Collage making, PowerPoint presentations, Digital Art and many more to encourage and explore the talent of the students.

FOREIGN LANGUAGE

In the era of Globalisation, it is always good to stay connected with the world, by learning a foreign language. Moreover, a foreign language improves cognitive abilities and enhances memory, problem-solving skills, and multitasking. With qualified staff, learning foreign languages, German & French, at VDJS is an enriching experience.





EXPERIENTIAL LEARNING

To promote innovative, creative and contemporary pedagogy, the theory classes are duly supplemented with practical knowledge. Regular lab sessions are held under the guidance of trained lab instructors in the well-equipped laboratories for Physics, Chemistry, Biology, Home Science, Language, Psychology, Geography, and Mathematics. Project Based Learning and ATL sessions have been blended into the teaching learning process to make it more wholesome.

LEARNING RESOURCE CENTRE

Centrally located, the School Library is unrivalled with more than 23,000 titles on a variety of subjects to help children rediscover the joy of reading. The Reading room also provides access to the latest periodicals, journals and magazines, besides the daily newspapers to keep students and faculty abreast of national and international events. The wide range of books caters to students of diverse interests. The Wi-Fi connection facility helps in using 'kindle'. A well-equipped Conference Room is utilised for conducting seminars and conferences. Each Boarding House is provided with in-house library to inculcate reading habits among the students. Efficient and helpful library staff facilitates selection of books and reading material besides extending advice on study skills.



OFFERING BUDDHA BOWL

Nutritious food is vital for growing students. Highly qualified & experienced staff from the Central Dining Hall management team run the operations along with trained chefs and serve nutritious, balanced and sumptuous vegetarian meals to the girls and staff. With an in-house bakery, a variety of wholesome snacks are provided to students. A comprehensive and balanced weekly menu is designed in consultation with dietitian. The menu includes vegetarian options from across the country and also Continental and other cuisines. The faculty members dine with the students to inculcate table manners and etiquettes. Also, there is a provision of providing special diet to students on medical recommendation.

CDH Prefects in coordination with CDH Committee, plan and propose the menu for the week. CDH committee comprises of Student Representatives, CDH Prefects, Teacher Representatives and CDH Manager and its meetings are held quarterly.

The menu is decided in consultation with the student body and is revised on a regular basis in accordance with the feedback received. The students look forward to attend birthday parties and weekly house visits here. Staff parties are also held there occasionally.

AUDITORIUM

An airy and spacious auditorium, with a seating capacity of 1000 people, is a multipurpose hall with latest infrastructure. It is used for conducting daily morning assemblies, seminars, conferences, Inter-House and Inter-School events. It also serves as an Indoor Badminton court and venue to conduct other central events.

The academic year commences in April and concludes in March. The Annual Examination for classes IV to VIII is held in the month of March and of Classes IX & XI in the month of February. Public Examinations for classes X & XII conducted by the Central Board of Secondary Education, Delhi, are also held in the month of March.

LEARNING BEYOND CLASSROOM

Academic excellence lies at the core of all our endeavours. The curriculum is calibrated thoughtfully so that students make steady strides and finally stretch targets are set for them with all possible institutional support. We provide our girls world Class Infrastructure supported by Integrated Learning Pedagogy. The Air-Conditioned Classrooms are equipped with Interactive Boards and Learning Management Platform along with individually held MAC Books.

Grow Green Programme: The Grow Green initiative has been introduced for Classes IV – VII to give the students hands on experience on organic farming. The students are trained to prepare the soil for growing certain plants like lemon, coriander, tulsi and many more. The programme instills values and aligns with the School's Go Green philosophy.

At the senior secondary level, the school offers Liberal Art courses to choose from 22 different subjects, supported by an adequately stocked and catalogued library and audio-visual department.

To perceive academia through the eyes of the learner, the Student Academic Council has been constituted which is instrumental in assessing the teaching-learning process in the school.

A continuous and comprehensive assessment to check the standards of our students not only at the school level but also at the National Level is done through various assessments like, Asset (English, Science and Mathematics), Olympiads and many more...





LEARNING WITH FUN

Educational excursions are conducted for the students every year within the country and abroad to complement the academic curriculum.

Being a part of excursions, service projects, conferences, and students' academic exchange programmes enables students to come out of their comfort zone and channelise their energy in a positive direction. They also promote adaptability and flexibility to survive in different situations.

Trips to the town and movies at regular intervals, ensures a strong element of recreation. It also provides opportunities for close and informal interaction between peers and between the teacher and the taught, thus enhancing the happiness quotient of the school.

SPECIALISED TUTORIALS

Mental & Quantitative Aptitude : Mental & Quantitative Aptitude has been found significantly impacting academic performance of students. It basically indicates a child's 'brain power' in many elements of competency, such as verbal, arithmetic, spatial, and logical thinking. Therefore, this course on Mental & Quantitative Aptitude has been introduced to strengthen the skills required in 21st century learning for classes VIII - XII. The classes are conducted completely in an offline mode on every Sunday.

The school offers proactive integrated enrichment programme in collaboration with reputed institutions in Science and Mathematics for students of classes VIII - XII for the preparation of competitive examinations facilitated by the school faculties and via outsourced faculties. These classes strengthen the basics in Science and Mathematics and help in

preparation for Medical / IIT entrance examinations.

The School also guides the aspirants to compete in different National Level Competitive examinations through Special Coaching Tutorials for Common Law Admission Test.

ACADEMIC SUPPORT SYSTEM

The Academic Support System is a programme which inculcates skills like collaboration, decision making and self-empowerment within the student body. Under this Programme students, who feel the need for extra guidance in a specific subject are coached by their peers who are interested in teaching and also have a sound command on the subject. The mentors are volunteers, who are recognized for their efforts in the form of an Appreciation Certificate awarded during the Annual Prize Giving Ceremony held in the month of May.

CO SCHOLASTIC AGENDA

A total of 28 hobbies & clubs ranging from Robotics to Gardening cater to our variously gifted children. We ensure opportunities for adequate and exemplary expression of literary, artistic, oratorical, technological and sporting talent of our girls. MAKING INFORMED CHOICES

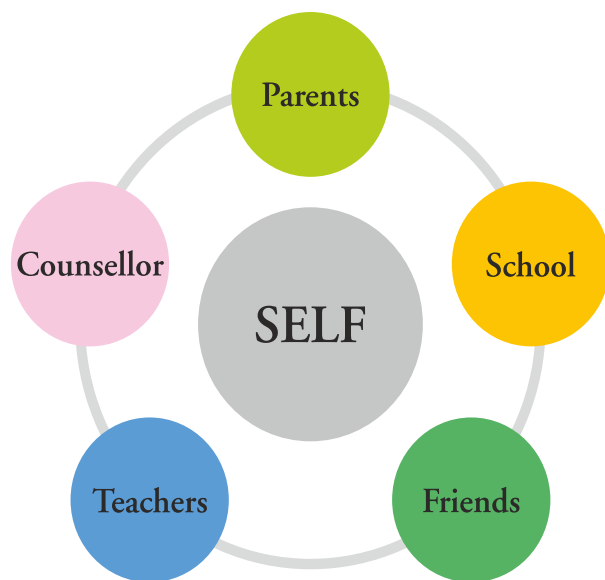

Recently, the first AFS exchange program was hosted by Vidya Devi Jindal School where a group of ten students along with a teacher escort from Selaqui International School, Dehradun, spent about a fortnight at VDJS. Green Schools Program

VDJS has been a proud member of the Green School Program since 2015. It is an environmental education programme directed to subtly sensitising students to the environment through hands-on and thought-provoking activities. National Cadet Corps

We are enrolled with 3 Har Girls BN NCC, Hisar which falls under Punjab, Haryana, Himachal Pradesh and Chandigarh Directorate. After a selection process, Class VIII students are enrolled in the Junior Wing and Class XI students in the Senior Wing. Each Wing continues its training for 2 years and the cadets appear for NCC 'A' Certificate Exam and NCC 'B' Certificate Exam respectively. Under the guidance of the School ANO, the students undergo rigorous training and take part in community outreach activities.

Generation Global

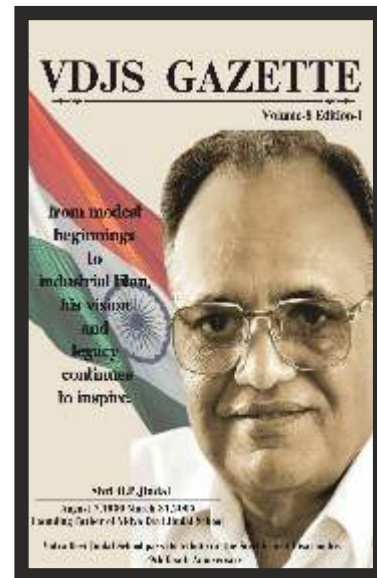

ACADEMIC YEAR & GUIDELINES FOR PARENT/GUARDIAN

The new academic session begins in the first week of April every year.

The academic session concludes with the final examinations followed by educational excursions in India/abroad. The excursions are optional and those who do not wish to join for the annual excursion return home for a two-week session-end break.

School closes for the summer break (mid-May to mid-July) and for winter break (mid-December to mid-January). In addition, students have ten days' Diwali break.

Leave during the term is not encouraged. Students are permitted only three days of leave during the academic year. However, such leave should not fall during the examinations or during the special events of the school, neither of these leaves can be in continuation of any of the above-mentioned term breaks.

Medical Leaves are sanctioned on the recommendation of the school Resident Medical Officer (RMO).

Parents are invited to visit the school to attend the special events and during the scheduled Parent Meets. Parents are welcome to visit the school on their daughter's birthday and can avail of a day outing for the child.

Reporting late after the vacation/leave : The school is making all out efforts for values to be ingrained amongst its students. Punctuality and discipline are two foremost qualities to be successful in life

Parents/Guardians must ensure that their ward returns to school in time after every vacation/leave. Attendance on the re-opening day after summer vacation/winter vacation/other break is mandatory. If, students return late after the vacation/leave or do not attend the school because of illness or any other reason without prior sanction, in writing, from the Principal of the school, a sum of Rs. 1000/- per day will be charged as a penalty for 15 days; after that the name of the child will be struck off from the school roll and full admission fee shall be charged in case continuance in the school is desired.

The safety and security of our students is our paramount responsibility. No unauthorized visitor is permitted on the school campus. Carrying the visitors' Identity Card is a must when parents'/guardians/acquaintances come to visit their ward/collect the ward from school. In the absence of an Identity Card, entry inside the school will not be permitted. Only Identity Card holders will be allowed to meet their ward.

Parents/Guardians must not hand over to his/her ward any personal medicine without the knowledge of the school doctor. All medicines must be deposited in the School Wellness Center with the school doctor.

Parents must not give eatables/cash/expensive gift items or any other thing that is banned in school as per the school policy to their wards. If confiscated, such belongings will not be returned, and the student and the parent will have no claim over such items. The school will not be responsible for any loss of money/gifts.

Parents must have a gate pass while checking their ward out of the school and the same shall be produced by the child when reporting back to school.

Parents are requested to take/bring their ward to the school in Travelling Kit.

Parents must make sure that while receiving their ward, by school bus at Chankayapuri Stop, Delhi/Sri Ganganagar destinations, Parents/Guardians only having valid School Visitor Card will be allowed to take the child, otherwise child will be brought back to the school.

Note: * Under normal circumstances the Address/Contact No./Email-Id/Local guardianship given in the Registration Form/LG Local Guardian Visitor Form shall not be changed. However, a request for change shall only be entertained if made in writing under the signatures of the Father/Mother. Any message sent by School on the given email-id shall be treated as conveyed to the parents.

SCHOOL'S CODE OF CONDUCT

Being a home away from home, VDJS envisions to be a vibrant community of compassionate learners for whom excellence is a credo. In a nurturing, stimulating, safe, caring environment, children are able to challenge themselves with zeal and commitment, thereby attaining standards of distinction, in whatever they undertake. To ensure that students attain their goals there needs to be a common code, which is clearly understood and practiced by all members of the community.

The ideal state of discipline is self-regulation. Rules and codes are meant to provide a frame of reference, for socially accepted behaviour. Clarity of expectations promotes harmonious living wherein we can lead responsible fulfilled lives and become contributing members of the society. The purpose of the Code of Conduct is:

- To create a stable predictable environment. Children need stability so that they feel secure and

can take charge of their own behaviour. If they have stability in one area of their lives, they will be able to face other areas of their lives that are not predictable.

- Good code also helps make predictions about how others are most likely to conduct.
- Good code instills effective behaviour and help create a stable foundation that prepare children to learn to face an uncertain world.

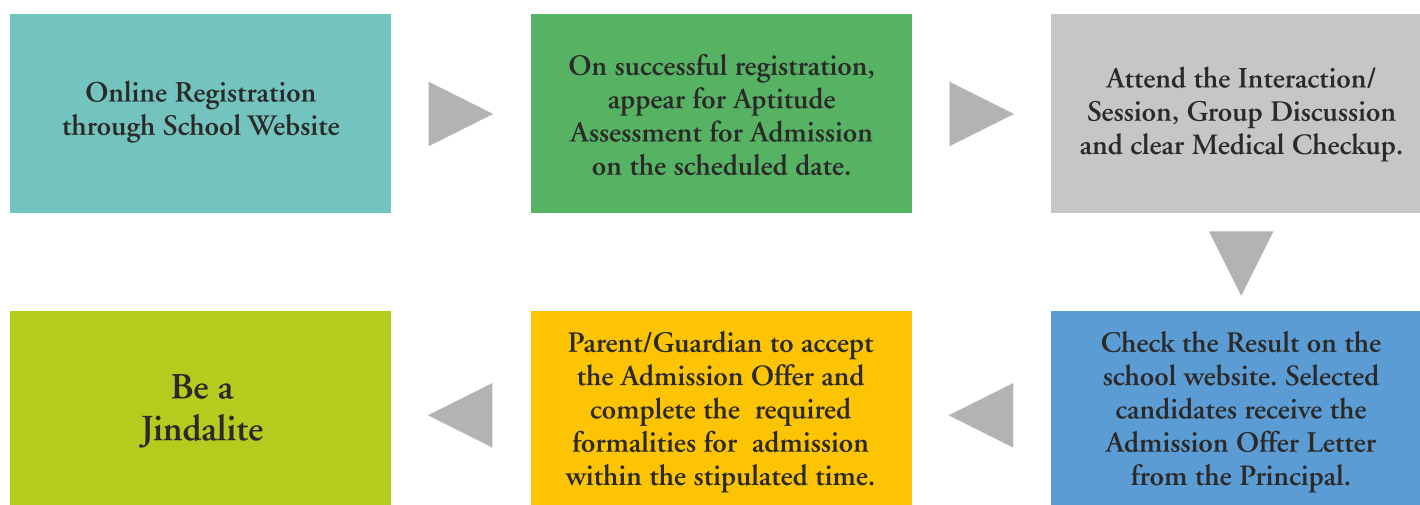
On the same lines, the School's Code of Conduct is framed with the objective that all disciplinary actions are viewed as learning opportunity for students to adopt more responsible behaviour. PROCEDURE FOR REGISTRATION & APTITUDE ASSESSMENT FOR ADMISSION/INTERACTIVE SESSION

The school offers admissions in Classes IV to IX and XI (provisional to be confirmed based on the Class X Board result) purely on merit irrespective of social status, religion, or nationality, subject to the availability of seats. The parent/guardian of the aspiring child must register the child for the Aptitude Assessment for Admission. The filled-in registration form is scrutinized if the child is of the right age and is seeking admission to the right class. On the successful registration of the child, the first milestone in the admission process for any child aspiring to be a part of VDJS is the Aptitude Assessment for Admission. The assessment focuses to examine the age-appropriate learning and skill set of the child. It is the evaluation of the basic developmental milestones of the child rather than a conventional set of questions to test her memory alone. The following flow chart depicts the admission process:

ADMISSION PROCESS

Post registration, the applicant is required to appear for the AAA at the specified centre of her choice (refer to www.vdjs.edu.in) where the test will be held on a date notified to the registered students well in advance. The AAA assesses the aptitude of students in Mathematics, English, Hindi and General Awareness. The style of the Interactive Session is intended to be informal and natural. Subject teacher conduct the Interactive Sessions to assess the student's reasoning and linguistic skills, ability to adjust in the boarding school life away from the comforts of home and to identify the interests and abilities of the child in the areas of sports and cultural activities. Students who qualify for the admission to school will be sent an offer letter within a week.

Registrations for Class-XI students are also opened in the month of September for the forthcoming academic session. AAA for provisional admission to Class-XI is conducted October onwards. In the absence of class X results candidates may be provided provisional admission. Provisional classes will start in the second week of April. A student who has been offered a provisional admission must subsequently obtain the required grades in Class-X Board Examinations for continuance in the school.

DOCUMENTS REQUIRED AT THE TIME OF REGISTRATION

1. Date of Birth Certificate issued by the Registrar of Birth & Death.
2. Latest Marksheet issued by the Principal.
3. Aadhar Card of candidate.

ADMISSION PROCEDURE

Students who make the grade for admission in Vidya Devi Jindal School must pay the first installment of the annual school fee and complete all admission formalities within 10 days after the receipt of the admission offer letter from the Principal. If payment of fee is not done by the stipulated date, the school reserves the right to withdraw the offer of admission.

RE-REGISTRATION

All registrations are done for a particular year and for the class requested for by the parent. If a parent wishes his/her

daughter to re-appear for admission test, she will be allowed to sit for re-test on the same registration.

DOCUMENTS REQUIRED AT THE TIME OF ADMISSION

The following documents are required as part of the Admission process for every student applying for admission:

- Date of Birth Certificate-Photocopy : Self attested photocopy of the Date of Birth Certificate issued by the Registrar of Birth and Death, be submitted as proof of Date of Birth. The Date of Birth informed/submitted at the time of admission shall be final and no request for change of birth date shall be entertained under any circumstances by the school. Misrepresentation or falsification of date of birth will result in cancellation of admission forthwith.
- Transfer Certificate & Character Certificate-Original : Transfer Certificate from the School last attended, issued by the Principal immediately prior to the student joining VDJS as well as a Character Certificate, are essential requirements and must be submitted on the day that the child joins School. Original Transfer Certificate duly countersigned by the District Education Officer in respect of students' coming from other recognized/Private school.
- Mark sheet/Report Card (Attested photocopy): The student is required to submit the Mark Sheet/Report Card of previous class indicating promotion to the next class, as well as proof of attendance for the previous year.
- Photographs -Two Passport Size photographs for Visitor's Form & Identity Card : Two photos each of mother, father and the other three visitors authorized by the parents to meet their ward. The parents can obtain maximum five Identity Cards from the school office for themselves and other three members of the family, who may be allowed to meet the student. Only Identity card holders are allowed to meet the student in the school and take the student out for outward and homeward journey etc.

Six recent passport size photographs of the student.

- **Agreement (Original)** : Agreement as per the draft given by the school, must be executed on Rs. 10/- Non-judicial stamp paper between the School and the parent. No child will be admitted without producing the Agreement.
- **Medical Certificate** : All new entrants are required to produce a medical certificate issued by VDJS. The parents must give an undertaking in writing to this effect. If the girl is found medically unfit, the admission stands cancelled.
- **Attested Photocopy** : Attested photocopy of the Certificate of School-Based Evaluation in respect of students admitted in Class-XI, coming from schools affiliated to CBSE.
- **Migration Certificate** : This is required for admission to Class XI in the case of students from Boards other than the CBSE and different State.
- Relevant certificate/proof duly signed by the OC/CO of the Unit/DSSAB/Station Veteran Cell to be submitted by the defence personnel for availing the defence concession.

Note: Until the Transfer Certificate and other documents are received by VDJS the girl's admission is considered as provisional.

WITHDRAWAL PROCESS

Student may be withdrawn from the school at the end of the academic year. Parents are requested to give intended withdrawal notice to the Principal before 15th March. The Transfer Certificate will be issued to the student in due course after clearance of all dues from the different departments. Request for withdrawal during the mid academic session under emergent circumstances, should be forwarded to the Principal at least one month in advance.

SCHOLARSHIPS

Deserving students are granted generous scholarships as we believe in promoting a meritocratic society. The Scholarship Scheme that aims to bridge the opportunity gap forms the underpinning of our all-around endeavours,

and we have been successful in achieving that so far.

Daughters of the Defence personnel (Presently working) get a concession in the school fee.

WITHDRAWAL REFUND

Admission Fee & Registration Fee are one time charges which are non refundable. Tuition Fee and Consolidated Charges will be charged up till the month in which the request for withdrawal is received. Balance Fee, Caution Money and balance amount of Imprest Account will be refunded through cheque by post.

DUPLICATE TRANSFER CERTIFICATE

On demand of issue of Duplicate Transfer Certificate a sum of Rs. 500/- (Rs. Five Hundred) will be charged from the student and it will be issued within a week. Money can be paid online in favour of Vidya Devi Jindal School, Hisar or in school A/c and detail of the transaction to be intimated to school through e-mail.

If Transfer Certificate is required in emergency within a day a sum of Rs. 1500/- (Rs. Fifteen Hundred) will be charged from the student.

STUDENTS' LEAVE/ABSENCE

Students are not permitted any leave except on medical grounds/extreme compassionate grounds. Medical leave will be granted by the Principal on recommendation of RMO. A maximum of three days leave may be granted for wedding of only real brother/sister in a session.

PAYMENT OF SCHOOL FEE AND OTHER CHARGES

The school Fee is collected in two installments as per the detail given in the Fee Structure. Parents are requested to read all the details given in the Fee Structure carefully. School authorities take no responsibility for sending separate intimation every time. Parents/Guardian are advised to make remittances within the due dates on their own. The total fee is payable in advance. A late fee fine, as applicable is charged in case fee is not paid by the due date. Parents have the option to deposit fees in advance.
